Report: TSRA Annual Board Retreat



On **November 18, 2023**, the TSRA Board members met at **Buffalo Ridge Wildlife Refuge**, to compare notes and apparently Trapper Keepers to plan for a fantastic next year for TSRA. In addition to holding the regular November Board Meeting, the Board put together our 2024 calendar, discussed what went well in 2023, what could be improved and held the first brain storming session for a new TSRA Strategic Plan.
